What is a Safari?

Safari is a Swahili word, which is originally derived from the Arabic word for travel, safara – but basically any place where one can observe animals in their true habitats can be a safari destination. Safaris are usually conducted in adapted 4x4 vehicles.

Watching animals from the security of a vehicle allows one to get closer to the animals with less danger to both animals and humans. Walking and mobile safaris are other options to view wildlife at close range, led by armed and experienced rangers and trackers. Guests usually camp out for a night in tents or semi-permanent camps. Alternatively, stay in one of the many excellent lodges in the various game reserves. Apart from land-based game viewing activities by vehicle, some lodges also offer boat trips (Botswana or Zambia) and others offer elephant back safaris. Some of the more luxurious lodges provide excellent spa facilities.

And now a glimpse at the daily schedule at a game lodge (timings/programmes depend on seasons and lodges).

Summer (December to March):

05h30: Wake up and morning coffee/tea will be served

06h00: Departure on morning safari

09h00: Return to the lodge for breakfast, after which guests have the opportunity to join a walking safari.

13h30: Lunch will be served.

16h00: Afternoon coffee/tea will be served.

16h30: Departure on afternoon safari, with a stop for Sundowners in the African bush.

19h30: Return to the lodge.

20h00: Dinner either at the boma, or at the restaurant of the lodge.

MADIKWE GAME RESERVE

Madikwe Game Reserve is a “malaria free” wildlife safari destination home to many luxurious game lodges. Besides countless other wildlife species, the ‘Big 5’ can also be found in the reserve. The reserve borders Botswana and is located in the North West Province, about a 3.5 hours’ drive from Johannesburg. Here are a few of the game lodges to choose from:

Game Lodge

Impodimo Game Lodge, situated in the Madikwe Game Reserve, is set along a rocky ridge commanding stunning vistas of the reserve. It is also located at the source of a natural spring, which provides the lodge with elevated views as well as riverine serenity. The lodge offers dawn and dusk safaris as well as bush walks. The safaris are carefully timed to ensure optimal seasonal comfort. Impodimo has 10 suites and each have been carefully positioned to ensure absolute privacy. Spacious in design, each includes a closed system fireplace, climate control air conditioner, mini bar fridge, tea & coffee making facilities and full en-suite bathroom and outside shower. Your private deck allows uninterrupted views of the Madikwe Game Reserve. Lodge features include: swimming pool, Intimate lounge, Library, Outdoor dining area (Boma & pool Lapa), Curio / gift shop, Wine cellar, Bush dinner venue and In-room spa treatments.



Jaci's Safari Lodge

Jaci’s Lodges are an oasis of calm and serenity in the arid African bush. On the edge of a small stream in the heart of the Madikwe Game Reserve you will find Jaci’s Safari Lodge. The lodge features eight luxurious rooms with large mosaic bath, outdoor shower and private deck, from which to watch warthogs rolling in the mud or tree squirrels darting through foliage. All rooms are equipped with under-floor heating and fireplaces to ensure that you are comfortable during the chilly winter months, and air conditioning and a ceiling fan to keep you cool during the summer days. The main lounge, with its views out across the stream, is where breakfast, lunch and high tea are served. The lodge includes a gym, and a play area is attached to the gym, in which children can be kept occupied while you work out and 2 swimming pools. There is a newly established Masala Spa, be pampered in the comfort of your room or relax and unwind in the soothing Masala room near the main lodge.



Madikwe Safari Lodge

Complete with 20 luxury suites, this Madikwe accommodation has a long history of providing absolute comfort and style within the safari getaway industry. Lauded for the renowned Operation Phoenix game translocation exercise, the reserve is well respected within the international community for its conservation activities. KAPAMA GAME RESERVE



Kapama Private Game Reserve is situated in the Limpopo Province and was proclaimed a private nature reserve in December 1993. Covering approximately 13 000 hectares of prime big game territory, Kapama Private Game Reserve has succeeded in combining the wilderness of the bush with the comforts of five-star hospitality and facilities. The name comes from Kapama, a Swazi king, whose tribe inhabited and hunted the northern Drakensberg mountain region around Mariepskop back in the 1880s. A game relocation programme was introduced and the reserve now supports a wide variety of game including elephant, buffalo, rhinoceros, and large populations of giraffe, impala, blue wildebeest and kudu. Predators include lion, leopard, cheetah, spotted hyena and many smaller species.

River Lodge features 42 guest rooms each with the following: Full ensuite bathroom, Air conditioner, Tea and Coffee making facilities, Mini bar fridge, Private balcony.

Activities

Accompanied by highly skilled game rangers, guests set out on early morning and evening game drives, to discover the wonder of the African bush and a unique encounter with its majestic inhabitants.

In addition to our inclusive safari experience, guests are welcome to participate (at additional charge) in numerous other activities and these include: Elephant back safaris, Clay pigeon shooting, Hot air ballooning, Visit to the Hoedspruit Endangered Species Centre, Bushveld sleep outs, and Bush dinners.

Guests are encouraged to join their ranger on a bush walk to explore the environment.

SABI SABI GAME RESERVE



Sabi Sabi Private Game Reserve, ecologically and geographically linked to the world famous Kruger National Park, lies in the Sabi Sand Wildtuin (Game Reserve).

This region of the Eastern Mpumalanga has a greater variety of game than Kenya. So diverse is its habitat and wildlife that you have an excellent chance of experiencing close encounters with the "Big 5" - elephant, rhino, buffalo, lion and leopard as well as six species of cat; twenty species of antelope, several dog-like species including spotted hyena, cape hunting dog, two species of jackal, as well as a variety of smaller mammals such as genet, squirrel, mongoose, civet, honey badger, porcupine and hare.

Sabi Sabi boasts the world's largest land mammal (elephant), tallest (giraffe), fastest (cheetah) and smallest (dwarf shrew) and a wondrous array of some 350 bird species. Botanically too, this is a wonderland. At Sabi Sabi there is a greater variety of plant life than in the whole of Europe. With its unique 10km frontage on the perennial Sabi River, biologically the richest waterway in South Africa, the reserve is blessed with a great diversity of habitat, from acacia woodland to riverine forest.
